

LIQUOR STICKERS

Monitoring liquor movement will help managers prevent bottles from "walking out the back door" or being given away to friends of employees.

Bottles are assigned a Liquor Sticker and entered into logbook by brand name and sticker number. Enter date when bottles received into store room, issued to bar and returned empty to management.

Periodic spot checks are advised to insure liquor bottles issued to the bar, but not yet returned, are still behind the bar and have not mysteriously disappeared.
