

The **Raspberry & Cream Block of the Month Quilt** is a sampler featuring Marsha McCloskey's Raspberry and Cream fabric line from Clothworks (due out in December, 2016). The quilt contains twelve different 9" (finished) Sampler Blocks. Each block is surrounded by four large triangles. A pieced border is formed by 14 Stepping Stones Blocks and 4 Double Fourpatch Blocks. Two plain borders finish the design. For ease of construction, sampler blocks, setting blocks (made of large triangles), border blocks, and setting triangles are set together in diagonal rows.

(This quilt features some of the block patterns from Marsha McCloskey's **BLOCK PARTY** book. The book which contains patterns for 120 blocks is now out of print, but can be found used online, if you want to add other 9" blocks to the project.)

The quilt pattern comes in a 3-ring binder with instructions for the shopowner and pattern pages to be copied and distributed to BOM participants. You can organize and distribute pattern parts and fabric kits to your BOM participants in any way you choose. Copyrights are given to the shop purchasing the pattern only for this promotion.

1. There are 12 different Sampler Block instruction sheets. Each is 2 pages (front and back). Printed pattern pages will be supplied in each master binder so the shopowner can make as many copies as needed. Each block finishes at 9" (9- $\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge). Some of the blocks are very simple, so you might consider doubling up some months.
2. The Pieced Border is made up of 2 different 9" blocks: 4 Double Fourpatches for the corners and 14 Steppingstones for the top, bottom and sides. Reproducible instruction sheets are provided for these as well.
3. Twenty various 9" Setting Blocks fill the spaces between the Sampler Blocks and Border Blocks. The overall effect is to surround each Sampler Block with large triangles. Piecing the Setting blocks of large triangles and joining all the blocks in diagonal rows is the simplest way to sew it all together.
4. Large setting triangles fill in the edges.
5. Simple Inner and Outer borders complete the top.

Rulers recommended for this project are the **BIAS SQUARE-PLUS** and the **PRECISION TRIMMER 3**.
