Note: Tape manufacturers normally include extra tape on the reel to accommodate "lead in tape". The lead in tape is tape for spooling and to accommodate variations in manufacturing at the beginning of the spool of tape. It's recommended to start recording at least one minute into the tape at 7.5 IPS.
