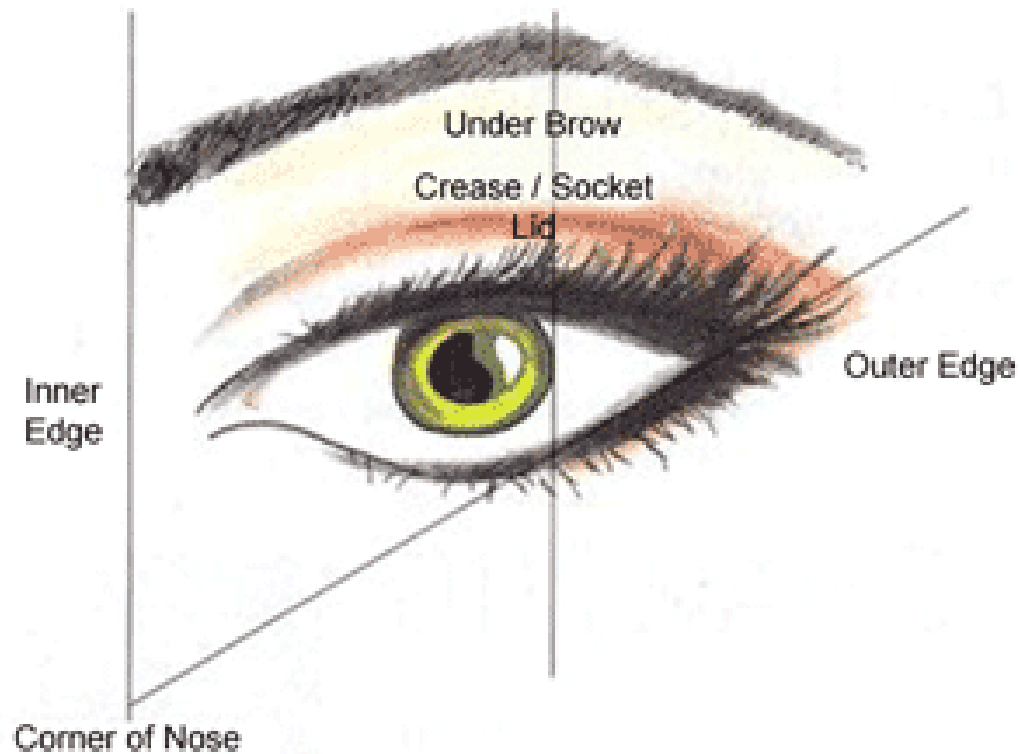


BASIC EYE MAKEUP APPLICATION



1. Apply Velvet Veil Primer to your entire eye area. A good primer can help your makeup stay on all day.
2. Apply concealer to your dark areas. Start at the inner corner of your eye where the skin tends to be darkest, then on the skin under the pupil, and finally on the outer edge.
3. Using an eye shadow base brush, cover entire eye area with Soft Beige 362 eye shadow.
4. With a fluff/angle brush, apply Grey Brown eye shadow slightly above the crease socket (cover 5/8").
5. Using a slant angle brush, line your lower lashes with Dark Brown eye shadow (line 7/8"). Smudge the bottom line with a fluff/angle brush.
6. Using a slant angle brush, hi-light under the highest point of your eyebrow with Ivory shadow. Put a bit of Ivory eye shadow on the inner corner of your eye lid and it will brighten your eye significantly.
7. With a fluff/angle brush, apply Blue-Green Mist 63 eye shadow over creased color and smudge-out the outer edge of your eyelid.
8. Apply Brownie retractable pencil (for brown or hazel eye color), Snake gel eyeliner (for brown, hazel or green eye color, Bonsai gel eyeliner pencil (for blue-green, blue, or green eye color) to the top and bottom of your eye lids. Line your eyes as close to the upper and lower lashes as possible.
9. Again using an angle/fluff brush, dab Ivory eye shadow on your brow bone, concentrating on your mid-brow outward. Blend with your finger. Now your eyes will sparkle.
10. Set with translucent loose powder.
11. Finish your eye application with Black mascara.
