



Polycarbonate Cleaning

Polycarbonate is very strong, but it can scratch and mark easily if not treated correctly.

DO NOT USE CLEANERS SUCH AS WINDEX, 409, or any spray cleaners on any polycarbonate.

FOR NON HARD COATED WINDSHIELDS:

To clean a dirty windshield, spray off with water to remove as much dirt/mud/dust as possible. **(NEVER WIPE OFF A DIRTY WINDSHIELD THAT HAS NOT BEEN SPRAYED OFF)**

After spraying off, use a **BRAND NEW or NEWLY WASHED** microfiber towel to gently wipe off.

Following these steps will extend the clarity of your polycarbonate. Over time the polycarbonate will still lose clarity because of its soft surface.

For Hard Coated/ Abrasion Resistant Windshields:

For the best results, follow the same cleaning directions as above. The hard coated polycarbonate will hold up much much better than non coated under most conditions, but they are not scratch proof (either is glass). You can wipe it gently during riding when dusty but you are at risk of scratching it if there is any grit on the windshield. Do not push hard when wiping to minimize the possibility of scratching the hard coat. The biggest advantage to hard coated is that they will remain clearer much longer under the same conditions.
