CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN IN UNPACKING AND ASSEMBLY OF THE VEHICLE. CHILDREN SHOULD NOT HANDLE PARTS OR BATTERIES, OR HELP IN ASSEMBLY. CHILDREN CAN BE HARMED BY SMALL PARTS AND SHARP EDGES.

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## Important Information

- This product is intended for use by children ages 18 months and up, and is not intended for children under 18 months of age due to lack of ability to operate safely.
- Maximum weight 15kg (33lbs). Only 1 rider at a time.
- You must charge your battery for 8-12 hours before you use your vehicle for the first time.
- Do not leave children unattended. Adult supervision required.
- This package contains small parts. Keep away from the children until assembled.
- Read this manual carefully for important safety information and operating instructions before using your vehicle. Keep these instructions for future reference as they contain important information.
- This vehicle is designed for use on: concrete, asphalt or other hard surfaces; on generally level terrain.
- Use this vehicle ONLY outdoors. Most interior flooring can be damaged by riding this vehicle indoors.
- NPL<sup>®</sup> will not be responsible for damage to the floor if the vehicle is used indoors.
- To prevent damaging the motors and gears, do not tow anything behind the vehicle or overload it. Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 15kg (33lbs).

## **Riding Warning**

1. Do not leave children unattended. Adult supervision required.
2. This vehicle is not suitable for children under 18 months and up.
3. Never operate the car on or near roadways, streets, nearby moving vehicles, swimming pools, creek, sloped driveways, alleys, steps, sand, dirt or gravel.
4. Never drive in the dark. Unexpected obstacles could cause an accident.
5. Never drive in rainy or snowy conditions.
6. Never operate near flammable vapors (e.g. gasoline, paint thinner, acetone, etc.) Using the vehicle near flammable liquids can or vapors could cause an explosion or fire.
7. Always sit on the seat and wear shoes.
8. Do not place anything near moving parts such as motors, gears or wheels. Rotating parts can snag hair, fingers, etc., which may cause serious injury.

## **Warning Tips**

Inspect the vehicle at regular intervals for wear & tear or loose hardware. Tighten the parts as required. Remove from service if any abnormal conditions such as cracks or breaks exist.

- Check all coverings regularly to make sure they are in place. Always make sure the seat is securely attached.
- When the temperature falls below 0°F (-18°C), it is not recommended to use the product outdoors.
- In extreme cold, plastic materials might lose resilience and may become brittle and crack upon impact. Store the vehicle in a warmer and protected place.
- Disconnect the battery power supply when the vehicle is not in use to prevent the children driving the car without adult supervision.
- Only use the charger/battery specified by NPL.
- The charger and battery are not toys and must be regularly examined for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts.
- In the event of damage, the damaged or worn part must not be used until replaced.
- Never modify the electrical system. Use of wrong type of battery or charger could cause a fire or explosion.
- Battery compartment and area under the seat are not storage areas. Storing other articles may create a fire hazard.
- Do not store any articles in or near motor compartment.

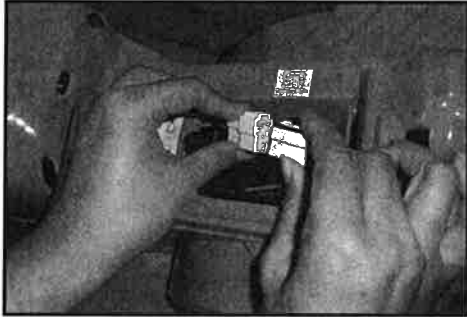
## Battery Charging

### IMPORTANT

1. Battery charging must be done by an adult. Never allow your child to charge battery.
2. It is normal for the charger to become warm while the battery is charging.

Before first-time use, please follow these steps for battery charging:

1. To gain access to battery compartment, simply remove the screw at the back of seat and remove seat.



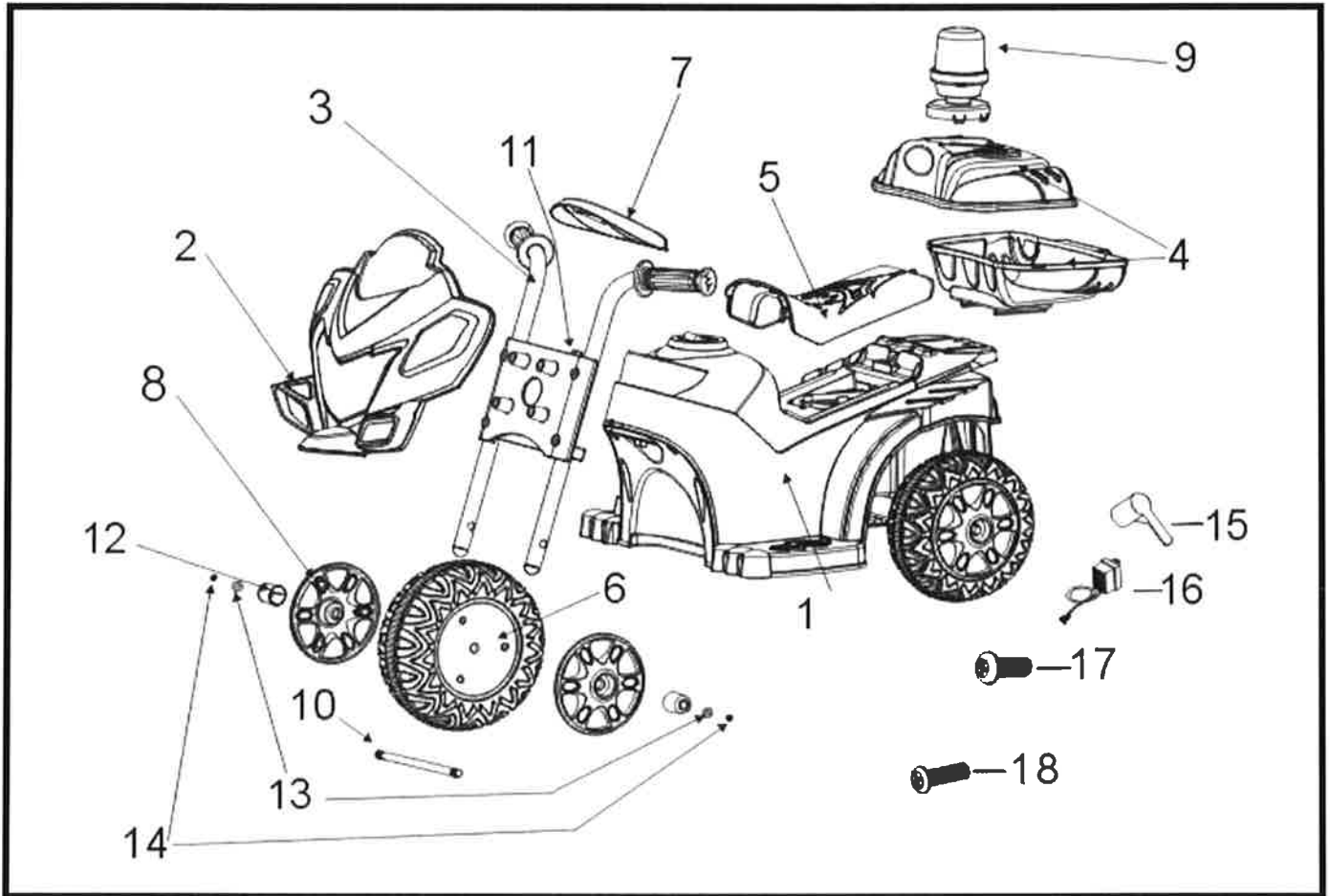
2. Before charging, make sure the volt and frequency of charger are in accordance with the outlet.
3. Charge the battery for 8-12 hours after each use. Never charge the battery longer than 24 hours.
4. After it is fully charged, battery plug must be connected back with the body plug.
5. Recharge the battery after each use, regardless of how long the vehicle was used. Do not allow the battery to run down completely.
6. Charge the battery for 8-12 hours once a month even if it is not being used.
7. Carry the battery by case. Do not carry the battery by the wires.
8. Supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

### Important Caution

1. Examine the charger and battery from time to time. If you find any damage, the battery and charger should not be used and must be replaced.
2. Battery life may be shortened if it is overcharged or undercharged.
3. Only battery and charger of the same or equivalent type are to be used.
4. Do not mix old and new, alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries.

## Parts List

- Please identify all parts before assembly and save all packaging material until assembly is completed to ensure that no parts are discarded.
- Metal parts have been coated with lubricant to protect them during shipment. Wipe all metal parts with a paper towel to remove any excess lubricant.



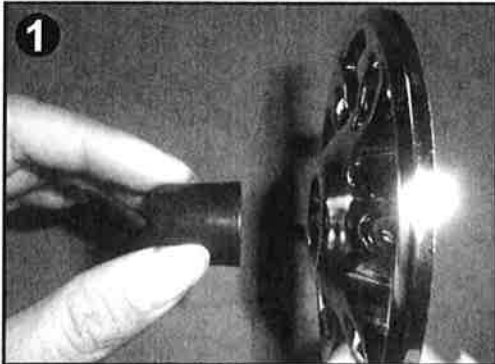

# Assembly

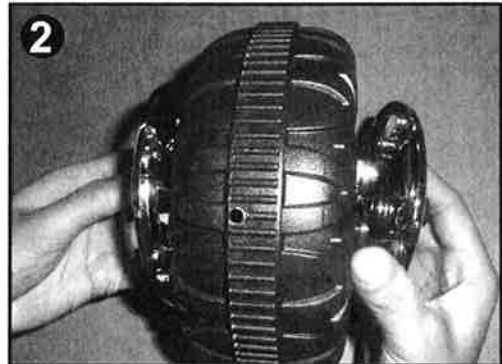

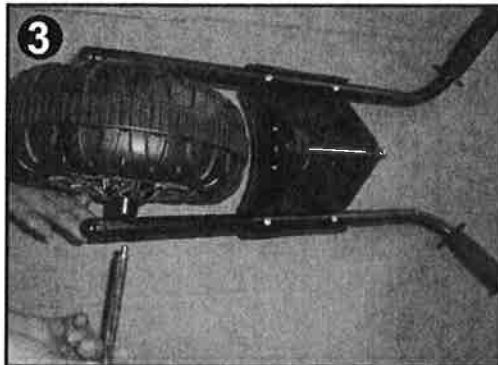
Children can be harmed by small parts, sharp edges and sharp points in the vehicles unassembled state, or by electrical items. Care should be taken in unpacking and assembling the vehicle. Children should not handle parts, including the battery, or help in the assembly of the vehicle.



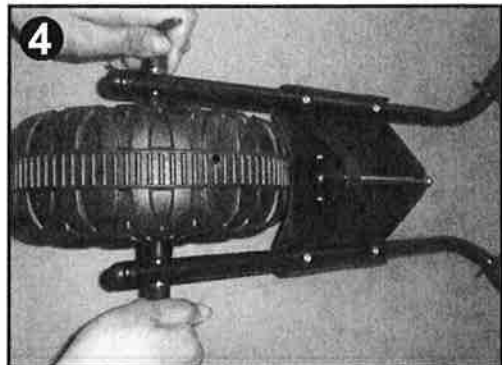
Align the axle sleeve onto the hubcap.



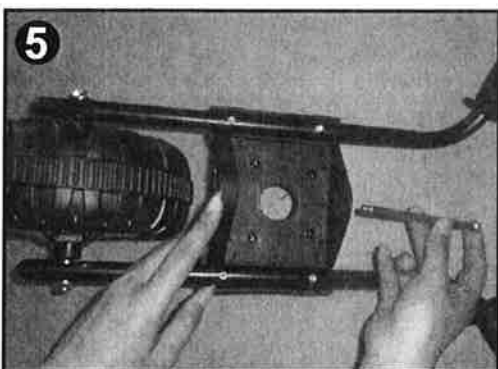
Align the hubcap onto the front wheel on both sides.



Align the bottom part of the head rack to the front wheel and insert the front axle through the front wheel.



Insert the washer and tighten the nut with the wrench (included) on both sides.



Unscrew the bolt from the head rack.

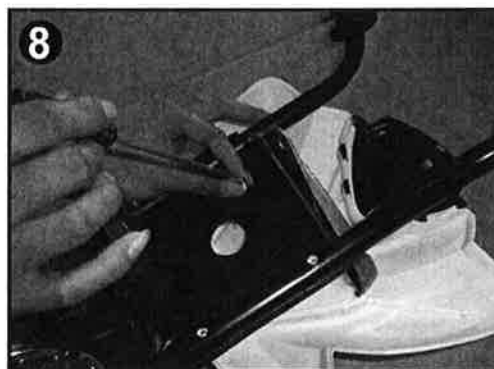


Fit the panel into the head rack.

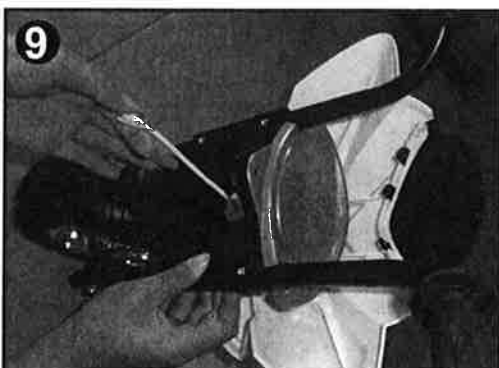
## Assembly



Fit the head baffle onto the head rack.



Fasten the screws (3.5x12) x4 pcs on the head rack.



Put the plug through the head rack.



Connect the wire socket from the head baffle to the socket from the main body.



Align and fit the body and head rack together.



Insert the bolt through the hole.

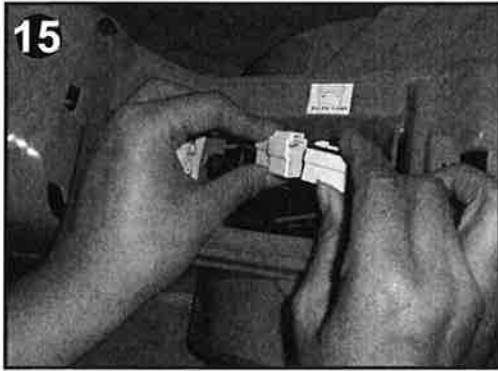


Tighten the bolt with the wrench (included)



Unscrew the screw (4x10) x1 pcs at the back of the seat and remove the seat cover.

## Assembly

Connect the socket from the main body and battery socket.



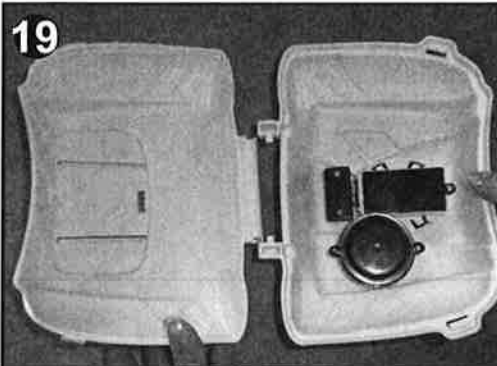

Snap the seat cover back to the main body and tighten screw with screwdriver (not included).

Unscrew the screw from the rear storage case battery compartment and remove the battery cover.

Insert 2 x AA battery (Not included) Replace the battery cover onto the battery compartment and tighten screw with screwdriver (Not included).

Align the top and bottom halves and snap on to connect together.

Connect the wire socket from the siren to the rear storage case.

Align the siren to the rear storage case and snap on to tighten the two together.

Align the rear storage case to the back of the main body and snap on to tighten both together.



## Operation

### 1. How to drive the vehicle

There is a forward and reverse switch on the body and an accelerator on the right foot pedal. When the switch is at the "Forward" position, vehicle will automatically move forward when the pedal is pressed. When the switch is at the "REVERSE" position, vehicle will automatically move backward when the pedal is pressed. The vehicle will stop after the pedal is released.

### 2. Light and sound

There is a switch for sound and light on the rear storage case. When the switch is at the "ON" position. It will make an alarm sound and the red light on the case will be flashed automatically. Besides, the front headlight will be on when the vehicle is started.

### Caution:

Make sure the vehicle has come to a complete stop before switching between "forward" and "reverse".

## Maintenance

1. You should inspect the vehicle to make sure it is in good working condition.
2. Clean the vehicle with a soft and dry cloth.
3. Do not allow the buttons to get wet.
4. Store the vehicle indoors during rainy or snowing weather.

## Trouble Shooting

Vehicle does not run	Loose pedal	Press the foot pedal
	Loose wire or connectors	Reconnect
	Wheel was stuck	Remove the obstacle
	Undercharged battery	Recharge the battery
Vehicle is sluggish	Overloaded	Follow the standard weight
	Wheel was stuck	Remove the obstacle
	Undercharge battery	Recharge the battery
Battery cannot accept a full charge	Charger was loosen from outlet	Reconnect
	Broken charger	Replace a new one
	Broken battery	Replace a new one
	Old battery	Replace a new one

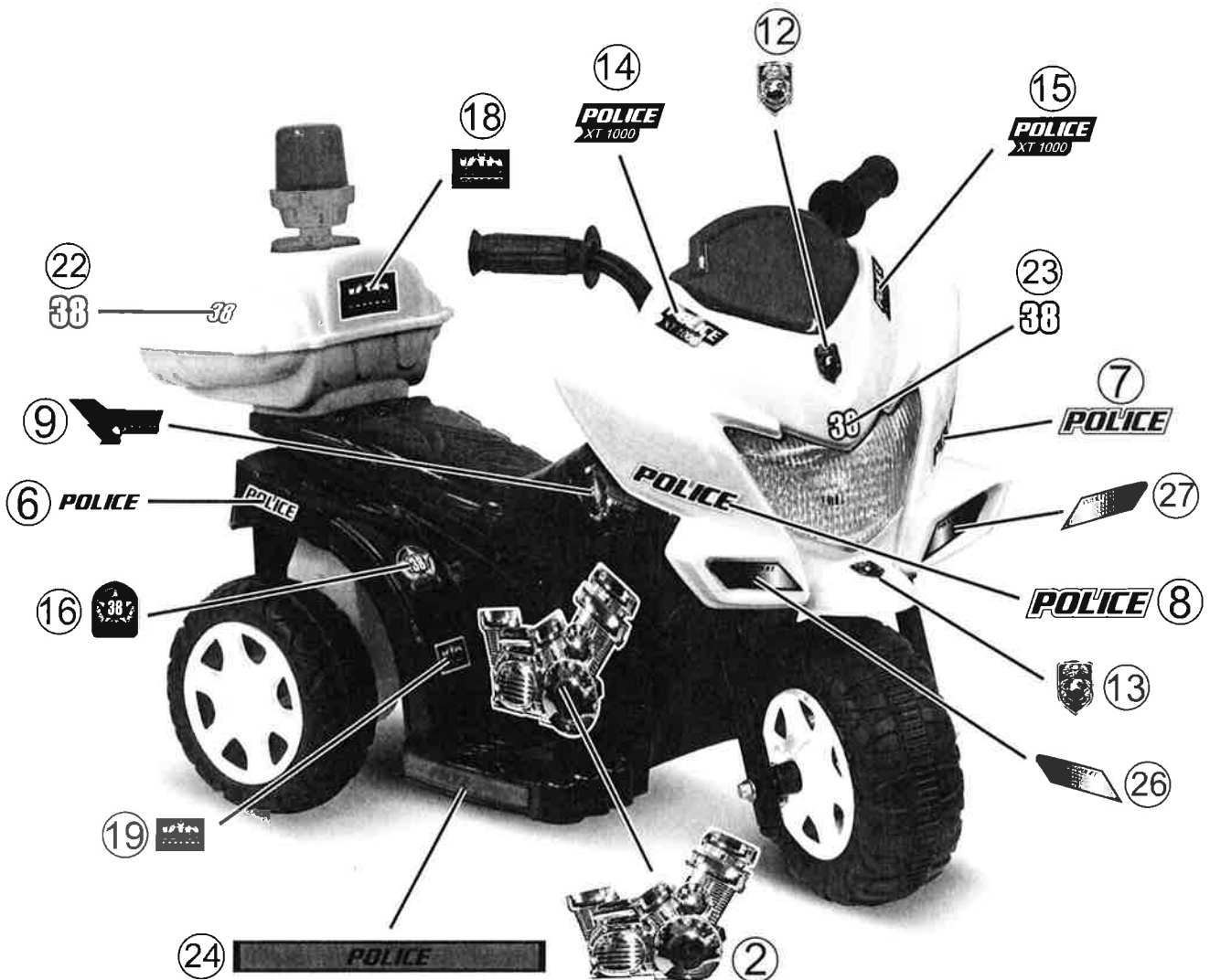
## Label Decoration
