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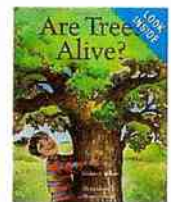
## World Tree Classification Cards

## Deciduous & Evergreen Tree Cards 16 Cards- Photo & Control Cards

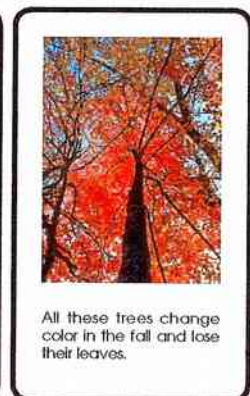
Autumn Leaves Are Falling, Falling, Falling!  
 Autumn Leaves Are Falling To The Ground!  
 The children sing. Their hands are falling & floating.  
 We sing and re-enact the season.

Children feel the magic of autumn in the air. Temperatures cool and sunlight lessens. Deciduous trees change color and lose leaves. Invite students to bring a leaf in for a leaf basket. Bring in pine cones from evergreens. Trace leaf shapes and cut them out. Build the parts of the tree puzzle. Match tree statues.

### Sort Deciduous and Evergreen Tree Cards to Labels.

Read the sequenced story of these tree cycles.  
 Students sort to the labels or the control photo card.  
 Good work for one or a group of children.

Kindergarten students lay out the cards. They pick their favorite tree to draw in their journals. They label it or write their own sentence. Or trace over the words I write for them. They may repeat this activity until they have quite a collection of trees in their book. Two students were picking out trees to draw. One said, "Which one are you going to do?" Her friend replied, "I'm doing the one with orange leaves." The other child said, "I'm doing the evergreen. It is a triangle."
